

RISC OS 4 End-User Licence Agreement

The upgrade kit to which this documentation relates (the "Upgrade Kit") incorporates software ("Software") which is owned by Pace Micro Technologies plc (or its licensors). Before using the Upgrade Kit and/or Software please read the End-User Licence Conditions detailed below. If you do not agree to the terms and conditions of the End-User Licence please do not proceed to use the Upgrade Kit or Software - repack the Upgrade Kit unused and return it to your supplier who will refund the amount you paid for it to you.

End User Licence Conditions for the RISC Operating System - RISC OS 4

1. Definitions

The following expressions have the meanings given here:

"Pace" means Pace Micro Technology plc, being either owner of all intellectual property rights in the Software, or having the right to grant licences for the use of the Software.

"Product" means an Acorn Risc PC and/or an Acorn A7000/7000+ which contains, and runs, RISC OS 3.7 1 or lower.

"Software" means the operating system programs, applications, utilities and modules comprised within the version of RISC OS incorporated in the Upgrade Kit.

"Upgrade Kit", means the upgrade kit which accompanies this document and which comprises the Software as a disk image (on tangible media) and a ROM image (embedded on a ROM set), or as a ROM image (embedded on a ROM set).

2. Licence Grant, Conditions and Restrictions

- (a) Pace grants you a non-exclusive, worldwide (subject to export controls), non-transferable (except as permitted by 2(b) below), royalty free licence to:
 - (i) use the Upgrade Kit so as to upgrade a single Product unit with the Software (such "use" to involve: (i) when the Upgrade Kit comprises a disk image and a ROM image, installing the disk image on the hard disk of the Product and embedding the ROM set (which incorporates the ROM image) into the Product, or (ii) when the Upgrade Kit comprises a ROM image (embedded on a ROM set), embedding the ROM set (which incorporates the ROM image) into the Product);
 - (ii) use the Software (once installed as aforesaid) upon and with the Product unit into which it has been installed.
- (b) You may - post installation of the Software into the Product - transfer all of your licence rights in the Software ONLY in conjunction with the transfer of the Product AND provided that the transferee has read and agreed to accept the terms and conditions of this licence.
- (c) You must ensure that the copyright, trademark and other protective notices contained in the Software are maintained and not altered or removed and that all such notices are reproduced and included in any copy of the Software.
- (d) Except as authorised above or expressly permitted by statute you may not: use the Software in conjunction with any other computer hardware other than the Product into which you install it; copy all or part of the Software; incorporate all (or any of) the Software into other programs developed by (or on behalf of) you and/or used by you; reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the Software; make the Software available, or permit its redistribution, for use with any other computer hardware than the Product into which you install it; rent, lease, gift, loan, sell, distribute or transfer possession of the Software in whole or in part.

3. Termination

This licence is effective until terminated. You may terminate the licence by destroying the Software (and all copies thereof). This licence will terminate automatically without notice if you fail to comply with any of its provisions. Upon termination you must destroy the Software (and all copies thereof).

4. Operating System Disclaimer

- (a) The Software is (to the extent permitted by law) supplied "as is" and Pace expressly excludes all warranties, express or implied, including (but not limited to) warranties of satisfactory quality, merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose and non-infringement (save to the extent that the same are not capable of exclusion at law).
- (c) In no circumstances will Pace be liable for any direct, indirect, consequential, or incidental damage (including loss of profits, business interruption and loss of data) arising out of the use or the inability to use the Software (save to the extent that such liability is not capable of exclusion at law).

5. General

- (a) This End User Licence will be governed by the laws of England.
- (b) The above terms and conditions supersede any prior agreement, oral or written, between you and Pace relating to the Software.
- (c) The media upon which the Software is incorporated within the Upgrade Kit is the responsibility of your supplier and Pace shall have no liability as regards any defects within said media.
